Many folks disappear from the meeting after booth breakdown. Tabled until next meeting, as there doesn't seem to be consensus on change now.

Stand for Council- Some concerns about shortcomings in performance from some individuals, and also in mentoring from others. What can be done? Suggestions: new councilperson-intake process with guidance and information packets. Mentoring, as part of better tools, and guidance to help fulfill duties as claimed, and in getting help when needed. A more unified council, a little more homework. How can we all work together, specifically for clear and timely information? We have to talk about and deal with these issues, we have a functional problem, we have feelings! Regardles of timelines, we need to choose our jobs carefully based on strengths and weaknesses We need to work together, we need to respect each other's individual levels of dysfunctionality...Our defensiveness needs to be replaced with what-will-help options.
